**Day 1 St. Louis, MO**

This summer, leave your worries behind and leave everything to us as we set out for fantastic New York, Washington DC and great American historical sites like Gettysburg, Jamestown and Williamsburg. Grab the kids and grandkids for a wonderful and educational summer tour!



**Day 2 CB, L Columbus, OH**

This afternoon visit the incredible Indianapolis Motor Speedway for an unforgettable racing experience that will make your pulse race! Your **Indy Track Ride** will give you the opportunity to ride on the legendary track of the Indy 500. Then make a pit stop for lunch at a unique restaurant that is a local favorite!

**Day 3 CB, D Gettysburg, PA**

Marvel at the 18th century small town charm of lovely Gettysburg as we arrive in the afternoon. This evening, **dine in a historic 1776 stone home** beautifully and authentically restored to its colonial glory and serving authentic, traditional favorites and regional specialties.



**Day 4 CB, L New York City, NY**

Learn the true story of those three famous days in July 1863 as you tour **Gettysburg Battlefield**. From Little Round Top to the Railroad Cut to Pickett's charge, the legends and stories, the tactics and heroics as well as the natural beauty make this an unforgettable piece of American history. Afterward, enjoy an Amish lunch which offers an incredible selection of fresh produce, baked goods and homemade delights. This evening, arrive in the Big Apple for the first of two exciting nights in this thrilling and wonderful 'center of the universe'.

**Day 5 CB New York City, NY**

Begin the day exploring the **Statue of Liberty** and Battery Park as you tour the legendary landmark and universal symbol of freedom and democracy. In the afternoon, visit the **United Nations** and begin the tour with a fascinating glimpse into the history and architecture of their famous building on the East River followed by exhibits on human rights and a visit to the General Assembly Hall. This evening, enjoy a New York night on the town as we attend a performance on **Broadway**.



**Day 6 CB Arlington, VA**

Leave New York this morning and enjoy the beautiful changing scenery on our way to the political metropolis and rich historical center of Washington D.C. Experience magnificent architecture, rich American history, incredible monuments and awe-inspiring memorials that make a **Washington DC City Tour** an unforgettable journey through our nation's heritage. Read the inscriptions on the walls at the Lincoln Memorial, see the impressive Washington Monument and admire the beautiful dome of the Capitol Building as you learn little known, local history from your guide.

**Day 7 Arlington, VA**

Begin with a visit to the National Mall and lifelong memories of discovery at the spectacular **Smithsonian Institute**. This unrivaled complex of 19 museums is the world's largest and features exhibits on everything from Presidential history to the Triassic Period as well as interactive science highlights, film, music and sport. In the evening, travel to the **Kennedy Center** for *Shear Madness*, a hilarious and classic who-done-it where the audience gets to solve the crime!

**Day 8 Williamsburg, VA**

Begin the day at **Arlington National Cemetery** and pay homage to fallen heroes as you walk among headstones that have chronicled American history since Arlington was designated a military cemetery on June 15, 1864. Afterwards, we'll make our way onward to America's first permanent English settlement, **Jamestown**. Experience the story of America's beginnings through film, artifact-filled galleries and outdoor, living-history museums that immerse visitors in two centuries of the great American story from 1607 to the Revolutionary War in 1781 and beyond.

**Day 9 CB, L Beckley, WV**

Begin this day exploring the house, gardens and plantation of **Monticello**, beloved home of Thomas Jefferson. The mansion, designed and redesigned by Jefferson for over forty years, is a masterful mix of art, history and architecture. For **lunch**, travel back to 1784 and enjoy the colonial ambiance of a local restaurant.

**Day 10 CB Louisville, KY**

Welcome to beautiful Bluegrass Country! Arrive in Kentucky this afternoon and enjoy green rolling pastures dotted with the fine horses this area is known for. Visit the premier thoroughbred racetrack known as the 'Home of the Kentucky Derby', **Churchill Downs** and learn the history and mission of this legendary host of equine champions like Secretariat and War Admiral.



**Day 11 CB St. Peters, MO**

Visit the **Louisville Slugger Museum & Factory** this morning and learn the story behind the bat and the company that still creates it today! This is the special place where they craft the Official Bat of Major League Baseball. Since 1884, they have put prime lumber in the hands of baseball greats like Babe Ruth.

**Day 12 CB Home**

Arrive home today after an exciting adventure full of big cities, bright lights and amazing American history.
