Day 1 D Westminster, CO

Experience the natural beauty and breathtaking National Parks of Canada this summer on a leisurely tour including an overnight stay in magnificent Glacier Park. The Calgary Stampede, the Columbia Icefield and Rail excursion are just a few of the highlights you will enjoy.

Day 2 B, L Sheridan, WY

Richly and authentically furnished rooms, historic exhibits and an intriguing glimpse into life in 1913 waits at the **Trail End Historical Site**. Admire the Flemish Revival architecture, wander the displays on Wyoming's colorful history and stroll the elegant manicured grounds. Day 5 Calgary, AB

Welcome to Thunder Road! Enjoy the pulse-pounding excitement of pounding hoofs as you place your bets and witness 36 drivers, 288 horses and teams of outriders as they vie for over 1.5 million in prize money. **The Calgary Stampede Chuckwagon Races** bring adventure with nine nightly heats and heart-stopping action.



Day 6 B Calgary, AB

Begin the day with a **sightseeing tour** of magnificent Calgary. The largest city in the Alberta province, this incredible region of foothills, high plains and Canadian Rockies boasts a colorful history and a modern sensibility sure to enchant you. In the afternoon, enjoy the excitement of another day at the **Calgary Stampede**. A prize purse of over \$2 million attracts the best cowboys in the world every year!

Day 7 B, L Lake Louise, AB

Explore the lovely city of Banff this morning and experience **Banff shopping** at its finest you browse the elegant boutiques and quaint shops filled with local arts, wines, collectibles, unique jewelry and clothing. Afterwards, travel to the **Banff National Park** and explore the slopes of Alberta's Rocky Mountains spanning 2,564 miles of valleys, mountains, glaciers, forests, meadows and rivers. Day 8 Jasper Alberta, CA

Board the massive Brewster Ice Explorer and begin the remarkable excursion onto the surface of the Athabasca Glacier for a 90 minute journey on the **Columbia Icefields** led by an experienced guide, full of information about glaciers, icefields and geological features, then take a stroll on the ancient ice and feel the power of this earth-shaping force.



Day 9 Kamloops, BC

Ride the current on a scenic **Athabasca River Float Trip** near beautiful Jasper on a leisurely ride past breathtaking views of the Athabasca Valley, amazing wildlife, natural wonders and rich history. Pass straits, islands and peninsulas bearing the names of men who charted this unknown arctic coastline and learn their tall tales. In the afternoon, board the **Canadian Rail** and pass settlements, farms and sawmills dotting a landscape draped in mountains, lakes and alpine forests and explore a region rich in history and natural beauty from the comfort and elegance of a train.

Day 10 L Vancouver, BC

This afternoon, take a **Vancouver City Tour** and explore the city set between the mountains and the sea on the spectacular Pacific Rim. A unique blend of landscapes and cultures this cosmopolitan city in the great outdoors features panoramic vistas from the Capilano Bridge and the Sea to Sky Highway.
