Michigan is packed with fun things to do in the springtime!

**Day 1 Effingham, IL**  
Adventure, breathtaking natural beauty, amazing local cultures and glorious Mackinac Island in full bloom will be yours this spring as we explore the Northern states of the great lakes and the many exciting things to see and do!

**Day 2 B, D Shipshewana, IN**  
Visit the heart of **Indiana Amish Country!** Gorgeous Shipshewana is a beautiful historic community bound to its traditions and boasting many wonderful things to see and do. Visit the **Midwest's largest Flea/Crafts Market** for everything from succulent fresh fruit to handcrafted furniture. See local artists and craftsmen demonstrate and sell their wares, search for antiques and sample some of the home-style Amish cooking offered at fine eateries in the area. This evening dine in one of Indiana's largest restaurants resembling a White Farmhouse!

**Day 3 CB, L Wyoming, MI**  
Experience the wild blue yonder as never before as we visit the **Kalamazoo Air Zoo** where over 50 rare aircraft are on exhibit, including World War II Bombers and the modern SR-71B Blackbird. This afternoon, the **Gilmore Car Museum** invites you to explore the eight historic barns, 1930's service station, small town train depot and nearly three miles of paved roads all filled with antique cars from vintage pedal cars to Pierce-Arrow in a pristine rural countryside. Lunch at the Blue Moon Café is included in your visit this afternoon.

**Day 4 CB, L, D Wyoming, MI**  
Welkom! The **Holland Dutch Village** is a springtime masterpiece of tulips and flowering gardens cradling fine, authentic Dutch architecture, peaceful canals and picturesque windmills. Stroll through the magnificent park and enjoy Amsterdam street organs as klompen dancers perform traditional dance and Dutch history. For lunch, sample delicious traditional delights from the old country! In the afternoon, watch the delightful **Children's Parade** as hundreds of children celebrate their heritage, dressed in traditional costumes. Next, watch expert craftsmen carve, mold and paint their unique works of art at the **Deklomp Wooden Shoe Factory** and learn their time-honored process of creating the only authentic blue & white delftware in the US. For dinner, celebrate Christmas in May at a restaurant decked in an elaborate Victorian Christmas theme.

**Day 5 CB, L St. Ignace, MI**  
Surrounded by the blue waters of Lake Michigan and Round Lake, scenic **Charlevoix** is truly a sight to behold. Enjoy a delicious lunch before visiting the world-class historic property of **Castle Farms**. Tour the lovingly restored French Chateau-style castle, stone buildings and exquisite formal gardens and learn the fascinating history of this rare find.



**Day 6 CB, L St. Ignace, MI**  
Breathtaking views of the Mackinac Bridge greet us this morning as we travel to historic **Mackinac Point Lighthouse**. This inspirational structure, cradled on a beautiful landscape dotted by pine trees against the sparkling sand beach, boasts an impressive history. Afterwards, zip safely to **Mackinac Island** as you enjoy spectacular panoramic views of the Straits for the open-air deck of the Mackinaw City Ferry. Upon arriving on the island, board the **horse-drawn Carriage Taxi** and begin your journey on this incredible island, free from motor vehicles of any kind. For lunch, visit the award-winning **Grand Hotel**, a classic resort nestled in the rich beauty of Mackinaw, where dining is still an elegant experience.

**Day 7 CB South Bend, IN**  
Begin your day with a visit to the **Studebaker National Museum**. Designed to resemble a 1920's-1930's dealership, this museum is home to a priceless collection of vehicles and artwork. This afternoon, enjoy delicious chocolates and treats made by hand in the family tradition, as you visit the **South Bend Chocolate Factory**.



**Day 8 CB Springfield, IL**  
Visit the impressive collections of the **Lincoln Presidential Museum** and explore various sides of the legendary statesmen through fascinating exhibits, artifacts and photographs that chronicle his life and Presidency. Follow the course of the Civil War, explore recreations of the White House, Ford's Theatre and Lincoln's boyhood home and view the original hand-written Gettysburg Address and a signed Emancipation Proclamation.

**Day 9 CB Home**  
Journey home to Kansas and Oklahoma after a wonderful springtime tour to Michigan.
